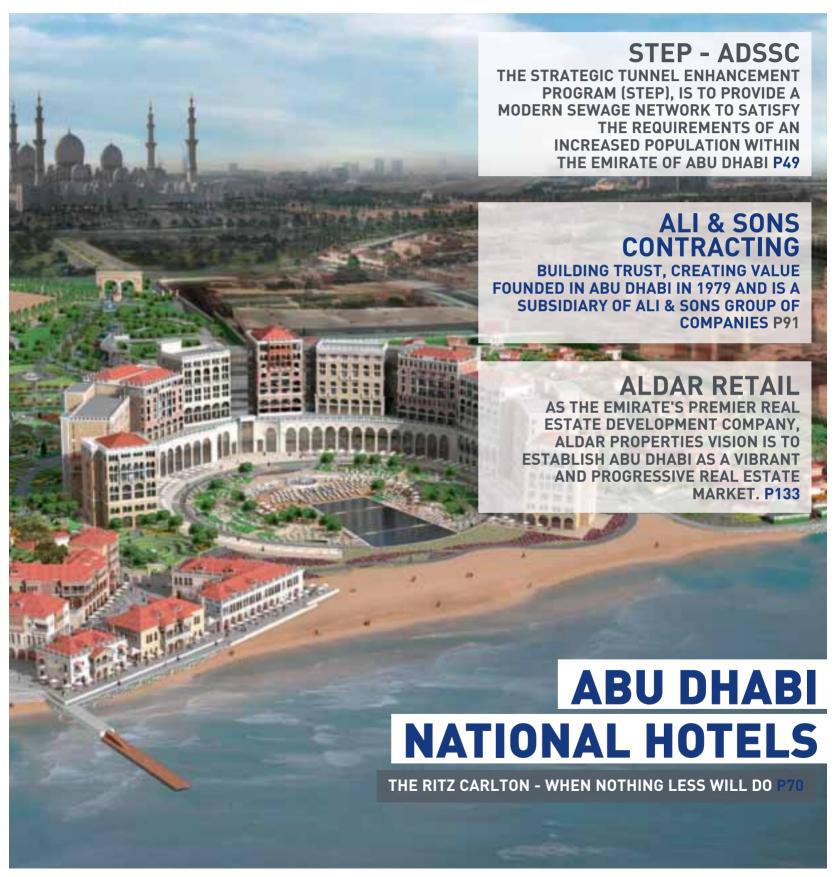

A Venetian themed hotel directly adjacent to the towering Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, The Ritz-Carlton Abu Dhabi, Grand Canal, enjoys what must without doubt be one of the finest locations in the Gulf.

This stunning location, with the Grand Canal running outside of the front of the hotel, certainly adds to the impact of the entrance and lobby. 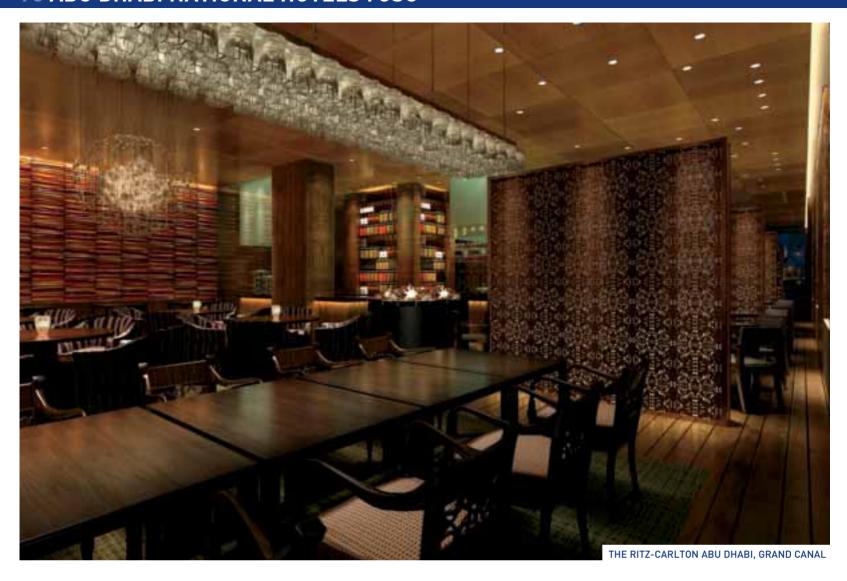

Riyadh.

The UK has also shown great interest, particularly in the villas, whilst there is enormous potential in the Russian market, once it can be persuaded to book standalone trips to Abu Dhabi instead of tying in a visit to the nation's capital with Dubai.

The Mace Group from London was responsible for the project management. According to ADNH, it was Mace's flexibility and capacity to swiftly mobilise in response to client needs that has been vital on the project, which has gone through some momentous changes, including a change of operator to Ritz-Carlton. The change presented challenges for Mace's project team, sending them back to the drawing board to have another look at the interior design and restaurant re-branding, all at a time when the fit-out process was already well underway.
